A Manhattan Waiter's Apron
 pattern

cutting guide:

FABRIC A:

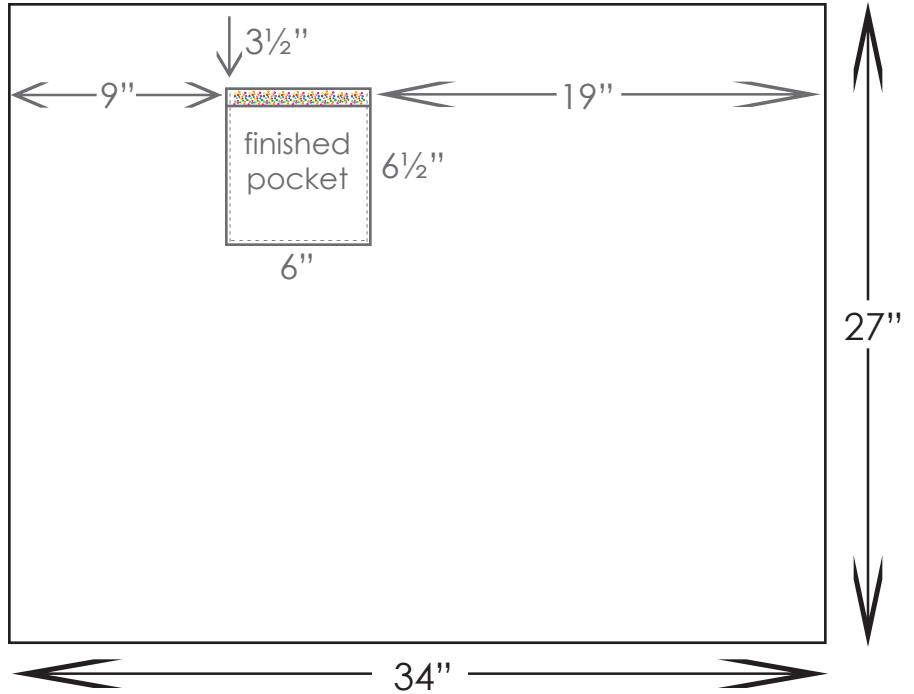
for apron body, cut one piece 34" wide by 27" high

supplies needed:

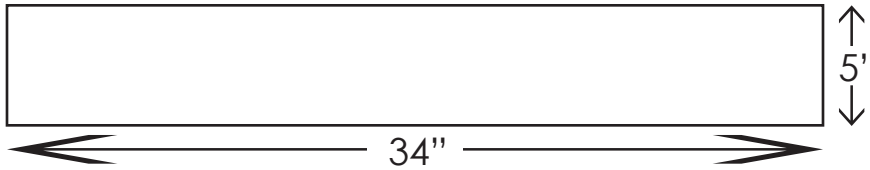
FABRIC A: $\frac{3}{4}$ yard
 (or more for a longer apron)

FABRIC B: $\frac{5}{8}$ yard
 (for ties & pocket)

2" ribbon: $1\frac{1}{4}$ yard
 (for hem & pocket binding)



FABRIC B:
 for ties, cut three pieces 34" wide by 5" high



for pocket, cut one piece 7" wide by 7" high



POCKET:

- Bind top edge of pocket with ribbon
- Press under three unfinished edges
- Edgestitch onto apron body per placement diagram (shown in grey)

HEM:

- Press lower edge of apron forward (right sides together) $\frac{1}{2}$ "--this will be covered by ribbon
- Place ribbon onto lower edge--wrong side of ribbon to the fashion side of apron--matching the pressed edge to the bottom edge of ribbon
- Stitch close to edges of ribbon
